



Notes and Comments on administration appointments, as of 12/14/04

(1) Lt. Gov. is a constitutional office, elected on ballot with the Gov. Duties under the Const. are (1) presiding over Senate, (2) in line to replace Gov.

(2) Art. 12, sec. 3 of the Const. provides that there shall be an Adj.Gen, appointed by the Governor.

(3) OMB, DOA and Personnel serve all state agencies. Scope of CIO's authority is currently unclear.

(4) BMV and Commerce are among the many line agencies. Each has some unique qualities, however:

- Commerce is unique in that (a) it has previously been under the Lt. Gov., and (b) it is in the process of being transferred, at least in part, to the Ind. Econ. Dev. Comm. (IEDC)

- BMV is unique in that it is in part a state agency, and in part (under the BMV Commission) a quasi-public agency.

(5) IEDC role within/without state government, and vis a vis Commerce Dept, is still in definition.
